

LEARY'S LAP

An unforgettable circuit of Tasmania exploring all corners of the island, named for friend and cycling companion Russell Leary, who inspired a group of mates to ride the full 'lap' of Tasmania.



DAY 1 Near Launceston, we visit Velo Vineyard, owned by ex-Tour de France cyclist Michael Wilson. A scenic bike ride through Tamar Valley vineyards takes us to the Beaconsfield Gold Mine, then back by vehicle to Velo Vineyard for platters of local produce and wine tastings. Get to know your cycling companions over dinner at the Sebel Market Square restaurant.

DAY 2 We drive you to Campbell Town, then ride to a vantage point near the spectacular East Coast; before completing the journey to Coles Bay and the eco-friendly Freycinet Lodge by vehicle. Afternoon activities may include a walk to Wine Glass Bay or relax on the beach. Watch the sunset over a gourmet barbeque on the deck.

DAY 3 A big day begins with a coastal ride to Swansea. We then travel by vehicle to Port Arthur to explore the Historic Site, before travelling on to Hobart to check-in at the famous Wrest Point. The evening is free to relax or enjoy the night life.

DAY 4 A free day to explore the city of Hobart – maybe take a river cruise or visit Mount Wellington. If you want to cycle a ride will be organised. Dinner is in the Wrest Point's magnificent revolving restaurant, The Point.

DAY 5 We travel by vehicle to Derwent Bridge in the Central Highlands to begin the challenging ride through the World Heritage Area to Queenstown. We board the West Coast Wilderness Railway to complete the journey by train to Strahan. Dinner is a seafood buffet in View 42 restaurant at The Strahan Village.

DAY 6 After breakfast, take an easy ride to the vast expanse of Ocean Beach and breathe the purest air on earth. Options today include a scenic flight over the wilderness by sea plane, a jet boat ride on the King River or the magnificent four-hour voyage with Gordon River Cruises across Macquarie Harbour and into the lower reaches of the Gordon.

DAY 7 We ride to the historic mining town of Zeehan then travel by coach towards Cradle Mountain. There's a challenging ride to reach Dove Lake at the foot of the famous peak. Afternoon options include bushwalks or a scenic flight. Dinner is at The Grey Gum at Cradle Mountain Chateau.

DAY 8 After an exhilarating ride through the hilly country of the North West, we enjoy a vineyard lunch at Barringwood Park Vineyard before transferring by coach to Launceston – the last stage of a Tasmanian circuit that will become a 'must-do' event on the calendar of touring enthusiasts.
