

# SUNSHINE, SPROCKETS AND SEAFARERS

A spectacular five-day ride through north-east Tasmania to the East Coast and back again, designed to take in the best of the region's wildlife, wine, beaches and coastal scenery.

**DAY 2** After a bus transfer to Campbell Town, cyclists begin the 50 km ride to the East Coast lookout, with sweeping views down to the sea. Enjoy a picnic lunch before making the descent to the coast. Our overnight stop is at Freycinet Lodge, beautifully situated beneath the Hazards within the Freycinet National Park. We'll get together for a gourmet barbecue on the spacious deck of the Lodge and watch the sunset over Great Oyster Bay.

**DAY 3** Take a break to discover Freycinet's many attractions – join an optional cruise offshore to observe marine wildlife and seabirds and taste local oysters with a glass or two of local wine; walk across to the famous beach at Wineglass Bay; or take a scenic coastal ride to Swansea. Dinner is in the Lodge's signature Bay Restaurant.

**DAY 4** After a hearty breakfast, we'll ride north to the fishing village of Bicheno, where the crayfish boats anchor in the spectacular Gulch, sheltered by a rocky island. Heading north to climb the challenging Elephant Pass, we'll meet for a picnic lunch at a scenic look-out near St Marys, then travel by bus to Launceston. After checking-in to Country Club Tasmania, it's your choice – relax in the fully-equipped health club, enjoy a round of golf or a game of tennis. Dinner is in the highly-acclaimed Terrace Restaurant, with its extensive wine list of over 500 quality wines and a seasonal menu showcasing the best of Tasmanian produce.

**DAY 5** Take an easy early morning ride or relax at the Country Club. Options for today include a visit to the city's spectacular Cataract Gorge, a Tamar River Cruise or your own time in the city of Launceston where many opportunities await. We can transfer you to the Launceston Airport or to your accommodation, if you're extending your stay in Tasmania.
